- Your college is interested in hosting K-12 schools to participate in Cybersecurity Competitions on your campus



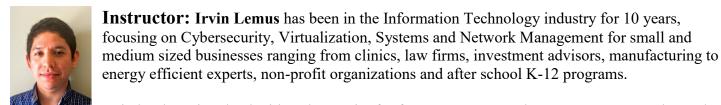
## **Workshop Overview:**
